2. Batik



2.1 Batik - Basic Information

- The history of Indian batik can be traced as far back as 2000 years.
- ‘Batik’ refers to the art of dyeing fabric by the use of a resist-technique; covering areas of cloth with a dye-resistant substance to prevent them from absorbing colors.
- The term ‘Batik’ is an Indonesian-Malay word meaning “a cloth with little dots”.
- The art of batik is a delicate, three-stage process of waxing, dyeing and de-waxing. There are also several sub-processes like preparing the cloth, tracing the designs, stretching the cloth on the frame, waxing the areas that do not need dyeing, boiling the cloth to remove wax and finally washing the cloth in soap. All in all, the production of batik demands comprehensive skills of the artisan paired with creativity and patience.



2.1 Batik - Basic Information



- H.O.P.E. offers a broad variety of handicrafts made in the traditional art of batik. Range of batik products comprise of wall hangings, shawls, cushions, handkerchiefs and religious artefacts like mass shawls and stoles.
- All batik pieces are made by women that have been trained by H.O.P.E. for this complex skill and participate in the gains from the sales. Thus this initiative of H.O.P.E. not only equips needy women for economic upward mobility but also helps to preserve this traditional Indian art.
